- Study authors and titles of books
- Compete in local Battle
- Advance to the New Mexico State Battle of the Books



The New Mexico competition is...

- Teams randomly formed from all registered participants
- 4 rounds
- Questions – “In what book...”
- Answers - always the title and the author
- Teams receive points for the correct title and author
- Awards for all members of the first, second, and third place teams
- Fun for everyone

How can your library participate?

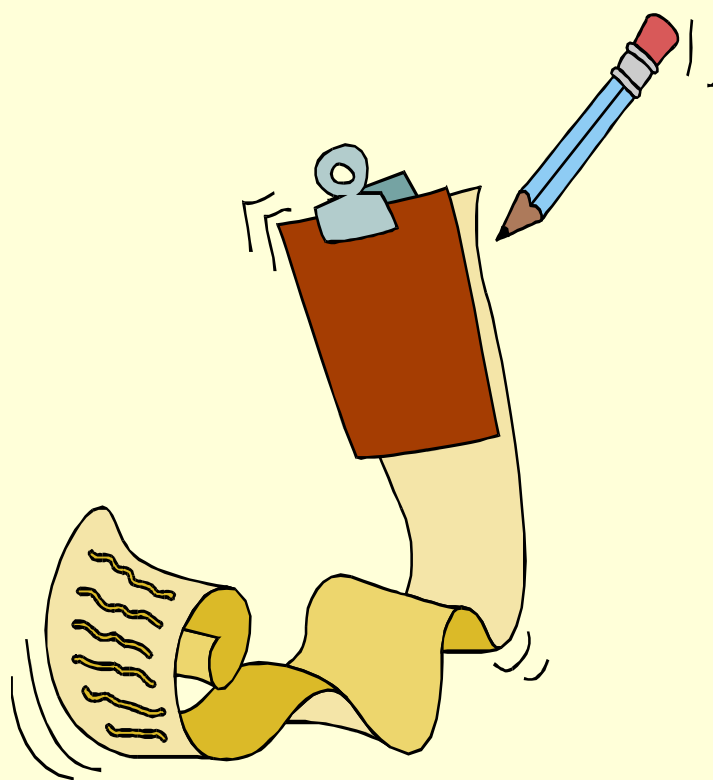
Visit www.nmbattleofthebooks.org

- They ask you, the Librarian.

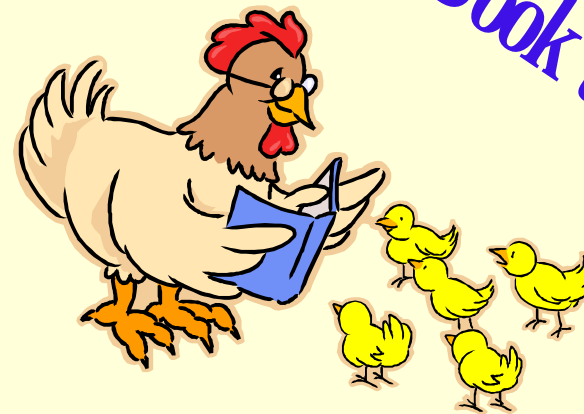
- You post the reading lists in the library.

How do you study for the Battle of the Books Competition?

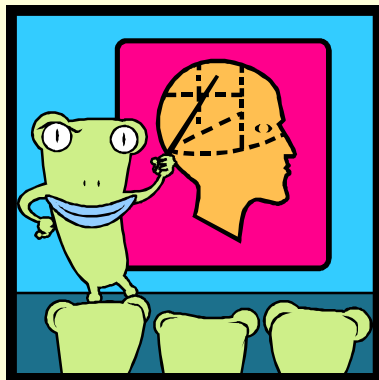
Crossword puzzles



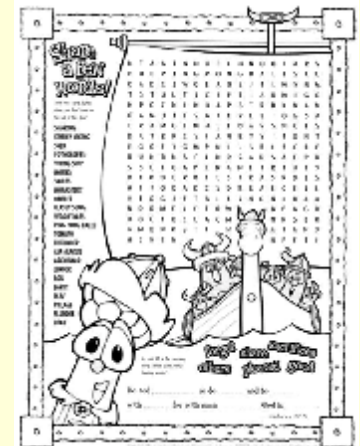
